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CONDITIONS FOR PARKING HEAVY VEHICLES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

1. The placement of Heavy Vehicles will be in accordance with the directions of the Council Local Laws Unit and will comply with the requirements of Section 3.5 of the Frankston City Council General Local Law2004 - Local Law No.7.
2. That Council assets shall be maintained at all times i.e. entry and egress of the vehicle to and from the property shall not damage assets such as the roadway, kerbing nature strip and footpath.
3. That no reasonable complaints be received relating to the following:
 - (I) Noise associated with the vehicle being unreasonable
 - (II) Times the vehicle is either started up for use or shut down at night
 - (III) Malodorous emanations of any kind from the vehicle and its parking bay
 - (IV) Road and cargo detritus deposited onto nearby pavements
 - (V) The unreasonable proximity of the parked vehicle to nearby residences and properties.
 - (VI) Any other deleterious matter that an Authorised Officer may deem to be associated with this permit.
4. A copy of a relevant current Public Liability Insurance cover for \$5m or more must be provided.

This Policy must show that Frankston City Council is indemnified against any liability arising from the activity subject of the Permit applied for.

A copy of a current Homeowners Policy, if it is endorsed to cover the applicant for Public Liability for \$5m or more is adequate for this Permit.

5. Any other conditions that Council Officers may from time to time require to be met.
