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SPECIAL CONDITIONS IN RELATION TO THE ISSUING OF PERMITS TO KEEP MORE THAN TWO UNREGISTERED VEHICLES ON LAND ZONED RESIDENTIAL.

1. The meaning of '**vehicle**' in this Permit *is a conveyance* as described in Road Rules Victoria 1999 and the Victorian Road Safety (Traffic) Regulations 1988 *and includes motor vehicles and trailers* but does not include water borne craft unless they happen to be contained on a trailer.

Under the Victorian Road Safety (Traffic) Regulations 1988 '**Motor Vehicle**' *means a vehicle which is used or intended to be used on a highway or in a public place and which has its own motive power and includes motor-homes.*

2. Trailers include trailed caravans.
3. No vehicle - subject of this permit, can be more than 4.5 tonnes gross vehicle mass unless it is subject of a separate permit for a heavy vehicle on residential land.
4. E.P.A. Noise Control Guidelines will apply to these permits and Council Officers will direct when mechanical work may be undertaken on permitted unregistered vehicles garaged on residentially zoned land.
5. Vehicles subject of this permit may not be serviced or repaired for financial gain.
6. Generally speaking spray painting of unregistered vehicles will not be permitted on residentially zoned land.
7. Council Officers will determine the maximum number of unregistered vehicles that may be garaged on residentially zoned land.
8. Having regard for the amenity of the area Council Officers will direct where vehicles may be garaged on residentially zoned land and the areas surrounding the garaged vehicles will kept neat, tidy and safe at all times.
9. The maximum period for which a permit will be granted is 12 months, extensions will only be considered upon re-application for the permit.
10. Permits will only be issued for the garaging of vehicles owned by occupants of the address subject of the permit application.
