Structure:	Heathland
Environment:	Deep infertile sand
Pre-1750 distribution:	Widespread and extensive except in southern area
Present distribution:	Scattered and uncommon
Status:	Secure
Notes:	Distinguished by dominance by Heath Tea-tree <i>Leptospermum myrsinoides</i> with little or no eucalypt cover, where eucalypts form a distinct layer the EVC is Heathy Woodland.
