### Description

Studio Park is a reserve which covers an area of approximately 8.1 ha, and is located 5 km from Frankston's CBD. Passive recreation such as walking and bird watching are the predominant uses for the park.

### Assets at risk

- Local residences
- McClelland Gallery
- Biodiversity

- Mechanical fuel reduction
- Prescribed burning
- Safety patrols
- Community education
- Emergency planning
- Weed management

### Fire history

An unplanned fire occurred within the reserve in 1993, burning an area of around 1.03 ha. Prescribed burns were undertaken in the park during the 1994 and 2004 fire seasons.

### Fire scenario

There is the potential for a fire to spread into the reserve from the north, or to ignite in the reserve. Vegetation management, tracks and other infrastructure may reduce the intensity and rate of spread of a fire in the area. A fire could be spread by a dominant north, north-westerly or south-westerly winds, pushing a fire towards houses to the south, east and north-east of the reserve.
