Pals Playgroup

The Play and Learn Supported (PALS) playgroup program is run in conjunction with BAM Arts Inc, providing a facilitated, activity-based playgroup that incorporates an inclusive dance experience adapted to suit all children participating. BAM is a Melbourne based not for profit that runs creative arts programmes for people with disabilities.

<u>MyTime</u>

MyTime is peer support for parents and carers of children with a disability, developmental delay or chronic medical condition. Trained facilitators assist carers to develop important social connections within their support group and to access information and services in their local area. A play helper is also available to look after pre-school aged children.

Play Connect Playgroups

PlayConnect playgroups provide the opportunity for children with ASD to engage in appropriate and supported play, which allows opportunities for children to grow, develop, engage and shine. The PlayConnect program also provides families with the opportunity to connect and share



experiences, while the facilitator assists them with information and links to relevant service.
