WHO CAN BE NOMINATED?

Citizen of the Year

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen and be 27 years or older on 26 January, 2021.

Young Citizen of the Year

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen and be under 27 years of age on 26 January, 2021.

Senior Citizen of the Year

To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen and be 60 years or older on 26 January, 2021.

Community Event of the Year

Presented to the person/organisation who has staged the most outstanding community event during 2020.

WHAT IS THE CRITERIA?

Citizen, Young Citizen and Senior Citizen of the Year

Recipients will reside in the Frankston municipality or have made a demonstrable noteworthy contribution to the Frankston community over the year, or have contributed an outstanding service to the local community over a number of years.

Awards are presented in each category for a valuable contribution during the current year, and/or an outstanding service over a number of years, to the local community over and above normal expectations.

Recipients have demonstrated an outstanding contribution and community service including areas such as: education, health, fundraising, charitable and voluntary services, business, environment or any other area that contributes to the advancement and well being of the community and is considered appropriate by Council.

Community Event of the Year

This award will be presented to the most outstanding community event staged between 1 January 2020 and 31 December 2020, within the Frankston municipality and organised by individuals or groups based within the Frankston municipality.

How are the nominations assessed?

Nominations will be considered by Council. Council may determine that no nominee is suitable for an award in a category. The decision of Council will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

In considering the nominations, Council seeks to satisfy itself that the person(s) concerned has/have met the criteria. The judging of the nominees will be based on the information provided in and attached to the nomination form.

How do you prepare a nomination?

Please read the criteria carefully before completing the nomination form. When completing the form, it is important to provide specific examples of how the nominee's contribution(s) have been outstanding. It is helpful to include examples that best show how the nominee has gone above and beyond what could be reasonably expected of someone in a similar position.
