

Best Streets Awards 2019: Terms and Conditions

Definitions

1. The 'Promoter' is Frankston City Council (ABN 4945 4768 065), 30 Davey Street, Frankston VIC 3199.
2. 'Competition' means the Best Street Award 2019', facilitated by Frankston City Council (ABN 4945 4768 065), 30 Davey Street, Frankston VIC 3199
3. 'Entrant' means the party entering into this Agreement as an entrant of the Best Street Award 2019–2020.

General

1. Information on how to enter makes up part of these Conditions of Entry. Entry into the Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights under these Terms and Conditions at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

Eligibility

1. Employees of the Promoter and agencies associated with this promotion and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.
2. The Competition is open to all ages and all residents, however entrants under 18 years of age must be supported by a parent or guardian when making an entry.
3. All entrants must be residents of Frankton City (or its suburbs), and reside on the street/court etc. in which they are nominating.
4. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and personal details concerning entrants; and, to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or who is believed to have tampered with the entry process.
5. The Promotion commences on 1 July 2019 at 9am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) and entries close at 5pm, Friday 23 August. Only entries that are received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions during the Promotion Period will be eligible for entry.
6. Entries received after Friday 20 September will be deemed invalid.
7. Incomplete or indecipherable entries will be deemed invalid and will be rejected. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry at any time without explanation.
8. The Promoter takes no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries. Incomplete, illegible or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid.

9. Any entrant who, in the opinion of the Promoter, tampers or interferes with the Promotion in any way, engages in unlawful or improper conduct that jeopardises or is likely to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Promotion, or who does not properly comply with the entry process, will be ineligible to win and will render all entries submitted by that individual invalid.

Competition entry

1. To enter, Entrants must complete the entry form available on Council's website and explain in 250 words or less why their street is so great to live on, focusing on what makes their street friendly, how the residents look after each other, how presentable and tidy it is, and the residents add value to their community and the environment.
2. Entries must be received by the Promoter during the promotion period.
3. Nominations can be made as a group, or individually. Anyone entering the competition as part of a group must reside on the street/court etc. in which they are nominating.
4. More than one entry per person is permitted to enter on behalf of their street/court etc. – however where more than one person is nominating individually, a group nomination is encouraged.
5. If this promotion is interfered with in any way, or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law to a) disqualify any entrant, or b) to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate.

Judging

1. Following entry closure, successful finalists will be contacted within six (6) weeks and notified of their finalist status.
2. Judges, including selected Frankston City Councillors and Council Officers will attend the nominated street to and undertake an inspection/review to ensure details provided on their entry are true and accurate.
3. Entrants will be assessed against the following criteria – Neighbourly friendliness, appearance and presentation, environmental sustainability, community involvement and any other distinguishing factors detailed in the entrant's submission.
4. Finalists will be notified within two weeks of entries closing, at which point the judging panel will arrange mutually convenient time to visit and assess entrant's street against their application.
5. Winners will be notified late October/early November.

6. A presentation event with the Mayor will be hosted with winners in December 2019.

Prizes

1. Competition winners will receive:
 - Sustainable Living Kit (valued at \$150), containing reusable Keep Cups, shopping and produce bags, straws, water bottle, energy saving thermometer, sandwich wraps and more. Limit of 10 packs available.
 - A private Street Arts Walking Tour (max 20 people). All participants must have entered the competition.
 - Photoshoot and media coverage in Frankston City News.
 - Invitation to attend a special presentation event with the Frankston City Mayor.
2. The Promoter reserves the right to alter prizes at any stage in the competition.
3. BBQ hamper to run your own street party event and celebrate your title as one of Frankston City's best streets.

Use of images and future promotion

1. As a condition of entering this competition, all entrants grant the Promoter the right to use their image/s in Frankston City Council promotional material. This usage is royalty free and includes but is not limited to any media including banners, signage, posters, magazines, television, cinema and internet including social network sites, DVD, MMS or other digital or print formats.
2. By entering the Promotion, Eligible Entrants acknowledge that their entry may be used by the Promoter, the Promoter's related entities or agencies engaged by the Promoter, for the Promoter's current and future promotional and marketing purposes without further reference or compensation to them.

Privacy

1. Frankston City Council is committed to protecting your personal information. Your name and contact details may be used to contact you for further information about your nomination and to arrange a visit to your street. If your street is chosen for a Community Street Award, we may invite you to be interviewed for a public promotion in Frankston City News. If your street is successful, you will also be invited to attend an awards ceremony. Council will publicise the winning streets and awards ceremony, including on social media platforms. Your personal information will only be used and disclosed as authorised by law.
