- All structures placed in parks & reserves must be weighted down by sand bags, water weights or concrete. Pegging is not permitted due to underground irrigation.
- For Weddings in open outdoor settings, only confetti that is biodegradable and environmentally friendly is permitted. Additionally the releasing of balloons or doves is not permitted.
- All attendees/participants/guest attending the event should be advised that parking is available around the area and normal restrictions will apply.
 Vehicles are not permitted on the reserve at any times.
- All areas around the event location are to be left in a clean and tidy condition. All rubbish must be removed from the site at the completion of the day's activities. Should the area be left untidy at the conclusion of your event, Frankston Parkland Services will clean the area at your expense.
