Thursday July 8th (6pm – 7.30pm)

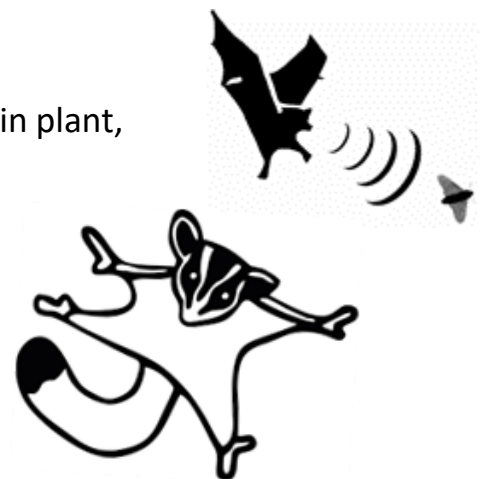
Baxter Park, Frankston.
