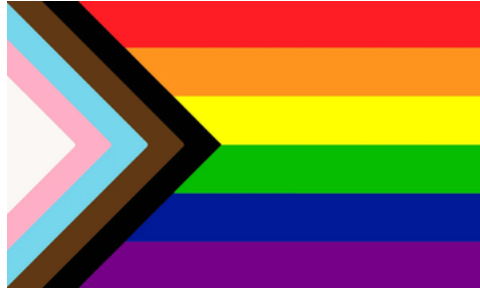

## GRADE 6 TRANSITION

Single session delivery per class In person or Online

This program aims to assist young people with the transition from Primary to Secondary school through exploration of strengths, support people and opportunities available to them throughout their high school experience. The importance of seeking support and the idea of Year 7 as a time for exploration and discovery are discussed. This program can be tailored to your school's specific needs.
