The FReeZA program is an innovative youth development program that provides opportunities for young people across Victoria to enjoy live ALL AGES events that are affordable, accessible, drug, alcohol and smoke-free in supervised and safe venues. The Frankston based FReeZA program is called 'Fresh Entertainment'.

For over 15 years, the Fresh Entertainment team has planned, organised and run all sorts of live events, such as Open Mic Nights, music competitions, local band showcases, as well as a stage at various local events, including Waterfront Festival.

#### Fresh Entertainment Youth Team

A group of volunteers who meet and collaborate to create live events for the Frankston community. Committee members can develop skills in event management, promotions and design, lighting/sound production, photography and more, as well as developing friendships and networks.

Volunteer audio engineers and music producers are trained, resourced and supported so that they can develop their own initiatives and projects at the recording studio with young local musicians and performers. Volunteers must be 18+ and are subject to an application and interview process.

#### INFORMATION SESSIONS

Audience Students This program aims to assist young people with the transition from Primary to Secondary school through exploration of strengths, support people and opportunities available to them throughout their high school experience. The importance of seeking support and the idea of Year 7 as a time for exploration and discovery are discussed. This program can be tailored to your school's specific needs.

The 'WHAT Program' aims to empower students by exploring various topics and opportunities, connecting them to community, and raising awareness of local programs, events, and support services that allow them to pursue their passions and aspirations, while providing ongoing support in response to current challenges and needs. This is done through engaging and interactive workshops, with the ability to tailor sessions to the specific student needs identified by the school and their young people. This targeted approach will ensure sessions are purposeful, relevant, and engaging regardless of year level and specific cohort needs.

The 'What Bus' is used for youth outreach within all Frankston LGAs and can also be hired out for outreach opportunities that align with Frankston Youth Services' core purpose in providing support and engagement for young people within the Frankston Municipality.
