



Frankston City Council Youth Services Behaviour Guidelines

Youth Services expect that you agree to treat everyone with respect and follow instructions while at our programs or events.

Behaviour NOT accepted at programs or events could include, but it is not limited to:

- Wilful damage to property theft
- Bullying
- Verbally abusive, threatening or using repeated putdowns
- Physically abusive, threatening behaviour
- Repeatedly ignoring directions given by workers
- Discrimination (Racist/ Ablest/ Sexist)
- Constantly talking over others (workers and young people)
- Smoking, vaping, use of alcohol or other drugs

Consequences of failing to abide by the above may result in the following:

- Discussions with Youth Services staff
- Time out of the program
- The workers contact the young person's parents/carer to discuss behaviour expectations in programs.
- The workers meeting with the young person and their parent/carer
- For some time (to be determined), the young person being banned from attending programs.
