Fresh Committee Background

Frankston's 'Fresh' committee is a group of young people aged 15-24 who are supported by facilitators to organise and produce six local arts/music/cultural events each year. Facilitators support committee members develop event management skills, build networks and bring their project ideas to life.

Fresh is funded by the Victorian Government's FReeZA program and Frankston City Council. FReeZA funds various organisations throughout Victoria to form youth committees and put on **ALL AGES** events that are **affordable**, **accessible**, **drug**, **alcohol and smoke-free** for young people across Victoria to enjoy.

For over 15 years, the Fresh Entertainment committee has planned, organised and run all sorts of live music events such as Open Mic Nights, metal gigs, art and craft markets, album launches, battle of the bands and art exhibitions.

Fresh members also have access to opportunities within the Fresh recording studio which is free resource for local, young artists and budding audio engineers to utilise.

- Passionate about music, arts and culture
- Hardworking and reliable
- Committed to tasks delegated
- Willingness to learn
- Willingness to seek support and guidance when needed

- Create and run your own arts/music/cultural events in a team from start to finish
- Participate in planning and delivery of (for example) Open Mic Nights, Markets, Live Music Shows, Variety Shows, and Festivals etc.
- Build your skills, connections, networks, confidence and experience

- Give local, young artists a launchpad for sharing their art

- Support the running of the Fresh Entertainment precinct at Frankston Waterfront Festival
- Be supported in your learning and practice by Fresh's Youth Worker facilitators.
