Are you constructing or altering a food premises?

If you are constructing a food premises or your food premises requires structural alterations, we offer a plans assessment service that provides written advice prior to the construction commencing or finalising. This will ensure the food premises complies with the structural requirements of the Food Safety Standards.

We recommend you refer to the following <u>Food premises design and construction guidelines</u> produced by the *City Of Melbourne* when planning your food premises.

It is not a statutory requirement under the legislation to submit floor plans for assessment. However, we strongly recommend this service to ensure any proposed works comply with the <u>Food Standards Code</u>.

This plans assessment service may be useful to help reduce costly mistakes before the construction finalises or starts.

Your plans should:

- Be drawn to a scale of not less than 1:100
- Show the layout of all fixtures and equipment, such as sinks, cooking and food preparation areas
- Provide a description of materials used for surface finishes including walls, floors and bench tops
- Indicate locations of waste disposal area, bin wash area, storage areas and toilets.

How long does it take?

An invoice will be issued to you for payment once a completed application and plans have been submitted. We will process and review your application within 20 working days. We will notify you via email of any requirements and conditions. Provided all other necessary permits have been obtained, works can then commence.

This Environmental Health review does not constitute a Planning or Building approval, and further approvals and considerations are required under the Building Act and Planning and Environment Act for the proposed facility to be both constructed and used. You must obtain this formal confirmation regarding any Planning and Building requirements from the relevant Council departments. Please contact each respective department on 1300 322 322.
