Cost of outings

Some outings incur a fee for ticketed entry, payable by the client. Everyone pays their own way at the venue. For example on a lunch outing, each person chooses their own lunch and pays the restaurant directly. The cost of a bus trip is \$3 return for local trips and up to \$6 return for longer trips.



You are welcome to bring your walking frame on an outing. Everyone who attends an outing must be able to climb the bus steps, look after their own personal care needs and keep to the schedule independently.
