

#### **Maternal and Child Health service**

Frankston City's MCH service promotes the health and wellbeing of children from birth to 6 years of age. Our MCH practitioners provide screening, advice and support on your child's growth, development and health needs. All essential bookings are made via Council's booking line: 9784 1756.

#### Immunisation session

Immunisation sessions are held at the centre on the second Tuesday and fourth Monday of each month. All essential bookings are made via Council's booking line 9784 1756 or online through https://www.frankston.vic.gov.au Eligibility:

- · children between zero and five years of age
- pregnant women
- catch-up immunisation (for anyone who has missed vaccines in Australia or born overseas)
- additional recommended vaccines are available for purchase
