



Frankston City priority projects

Key advocacy initiatives for Victorian Government investment

Frankston City Council invites funding contributions from the State Government towards the following key projects within the Carrum State Electorate (Seaford, Carrum Downs, Skye, Sandhurst).

Shared User Path Improvements

Eel Race Road Shared User Path

Design, approvals and construction of a concrete shared pedestrian and cyclist path along Eel Race Road in Seaford/Carrum from Station Street to Patterson River Secondary College and a wider pedestrian and cyclist bridge over Kananook Creek.

The project can be delivered as one whole project or in the following stages:

Staging	Cost	Timing
Stage 1a: Design, approvals and construction of SUP from Station Street to the west side of Kananook Creek Bridge on Eel Race Road (240 metres).	\$700,000 \$350,000 State \$350,000 FCC	24 months
Stage 1b: Construction of a SUP from the east side of Kananook Creek Bridge on Eel Race Road to Patterson River Secondary College.	\$1.05 million \$525,000 State \$525,000 FCC	12 months
Stage 2: Design and construction of an upgraded pedestrian and cyclist bridge (35 metres) over Kananook Creek along Eel Race Road.	\$1.875 million \$937,000 State \$937,000 FCC	12 months

McCormicks Road Shared User Path

Design and construction of a 1.8 kilometre concrete shared pedestrian and cyclist path along McCormicks Road across Carrum Downs, Skye and Sandhurst communities from Sandhurst Boulevard to the recently upgraded Hall Road.

The project can be delivered as one whole project or in the following stages:

Staging	Cost	Timing
Stage 1: Design, approvals and construction of a 1 kilometre SUP from Sandhurst Boulevard along McCormicks Road to Bunnings Road.	\$800,000 \$400,000 State \$400,000 FCC	24 months
Stage 2: Construction of an 800 metre SUP from Bunnings Road (connecting to stage 1) along McCormicks Road to Hall Road.	\$1 million \$500,000 State \$500,000 FCC	12 months

Frankston-Dandenong Road Shared User Path

Design and construction of a 1.8 kilometre concrete shared pedestrian and cyclist path along Frankston-Dandenong Road in Carrum Downs (State Government owned and managed major arterial) from Boundary Road (Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve) to Thompson Road.

This project is best delivered in one stage due to there being no suitable end point along the major arterial road. A suitable staging option may be to deliver construction funding over two (2) financial years as detailed below.

Staging	Cost	Timing
Stage 1: Design, approvals and construction of a 1 kilometre SUP between Boundary Road and 774 Frankston Dandenong Road.	\$900,000 \$450,000 State \$450,000 FCC	24 months Construction in later half of FY
Stage 2: Construction of an 800 metre SUP from between 774 Frankston-Dandenong Road (connecting to stage 1) and Thompson Road.	\$700,000 \$350,000 State \$350,000 FCC	12 months Construction in first half of FY

Play Spaces

- **Heritage Reserve (Skye) Play Space Upgrade and Multi-use Court** - 25/26 \$480,000, early design phase. Heritage Reserve, Skye play and multi-use court is a Local level play space budgeted for design in 24/25 and delivery in 25/26.
- **Gamble Reserve (Carrum Downs) Play Space Upgrade** - \$350,000 design 24/25 and delivery 25/26, early design phase underway.
