Frankston City Council Supplier Code of Conduct

Frankston City Council is committed to ensuring its contractors, consultants and suppliers engage in ethical and sustainable behaviours when providing goods and services to Council, including construction works and services. To support this commitment, Council has implemented a Supplier Code of Conduct.

The Code describes Council's minimum expectations for the achievement of a professional and productive work culture, characterised by the absence of any form of unlawful or inappropriate behaviour.

Council seeks to work with Suppliers so that Suppliers will meet and exceed Council's minimum expectations as outlined in the Code.

Council's expectations as set out in the Code do not supersede or alter a Supplier's regulatory and contractual obligations. Rather they work in conjunction with these obligations.

The Code will apply to all contracts, agreements and orders for the supply of goods and services and construction works and services from **31 March 2020**.
